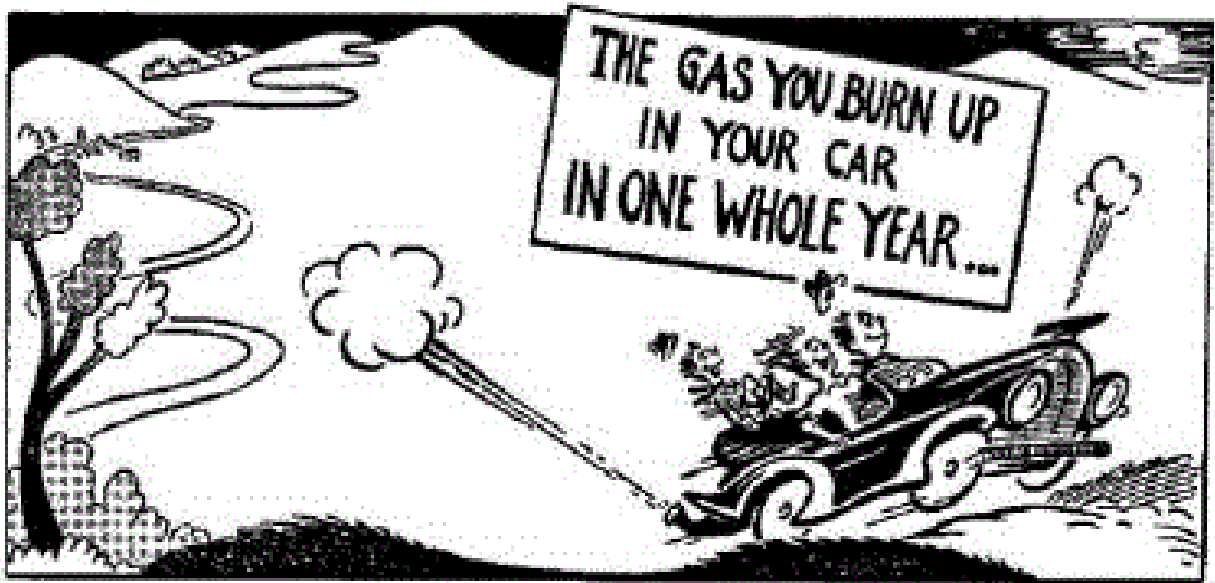

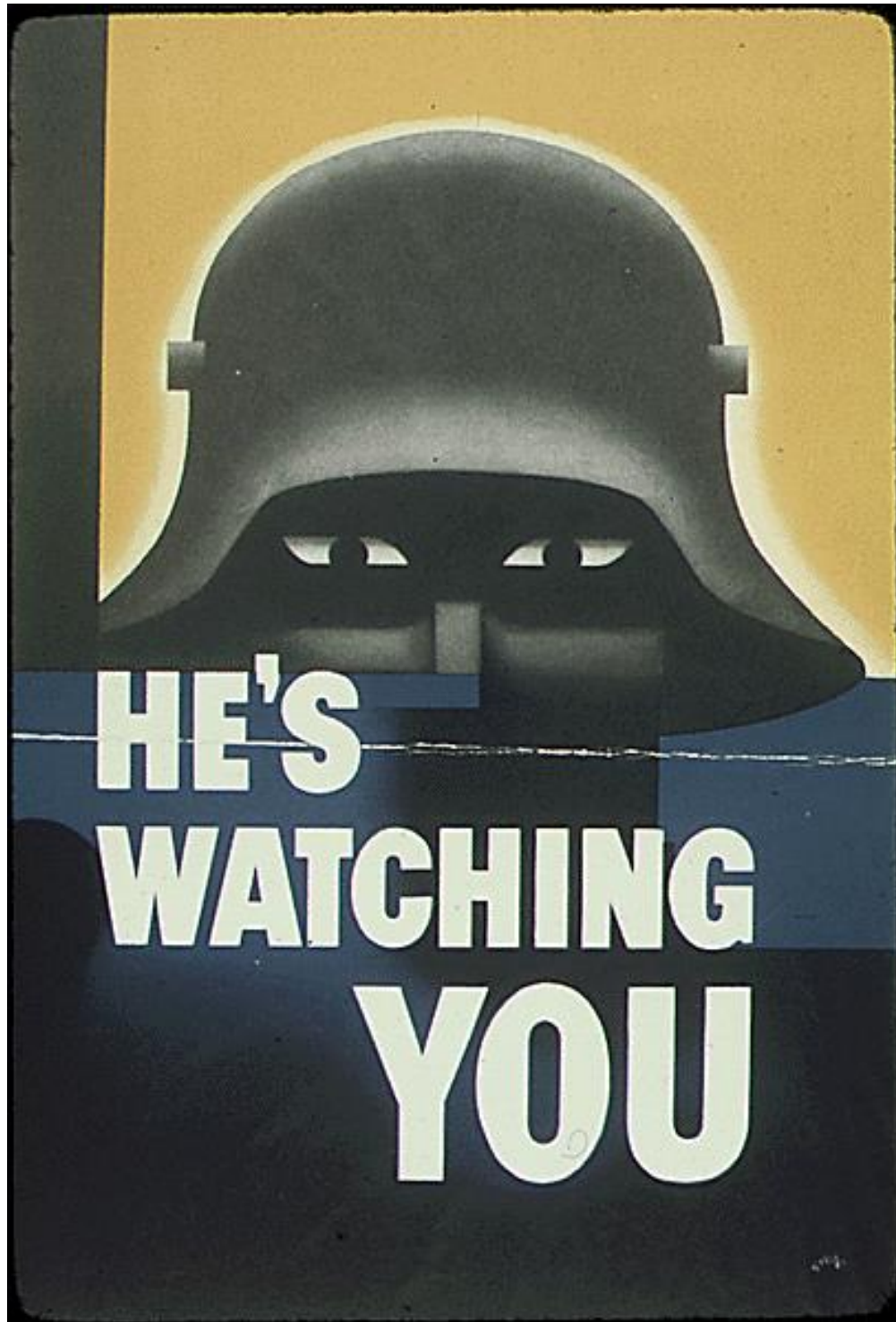

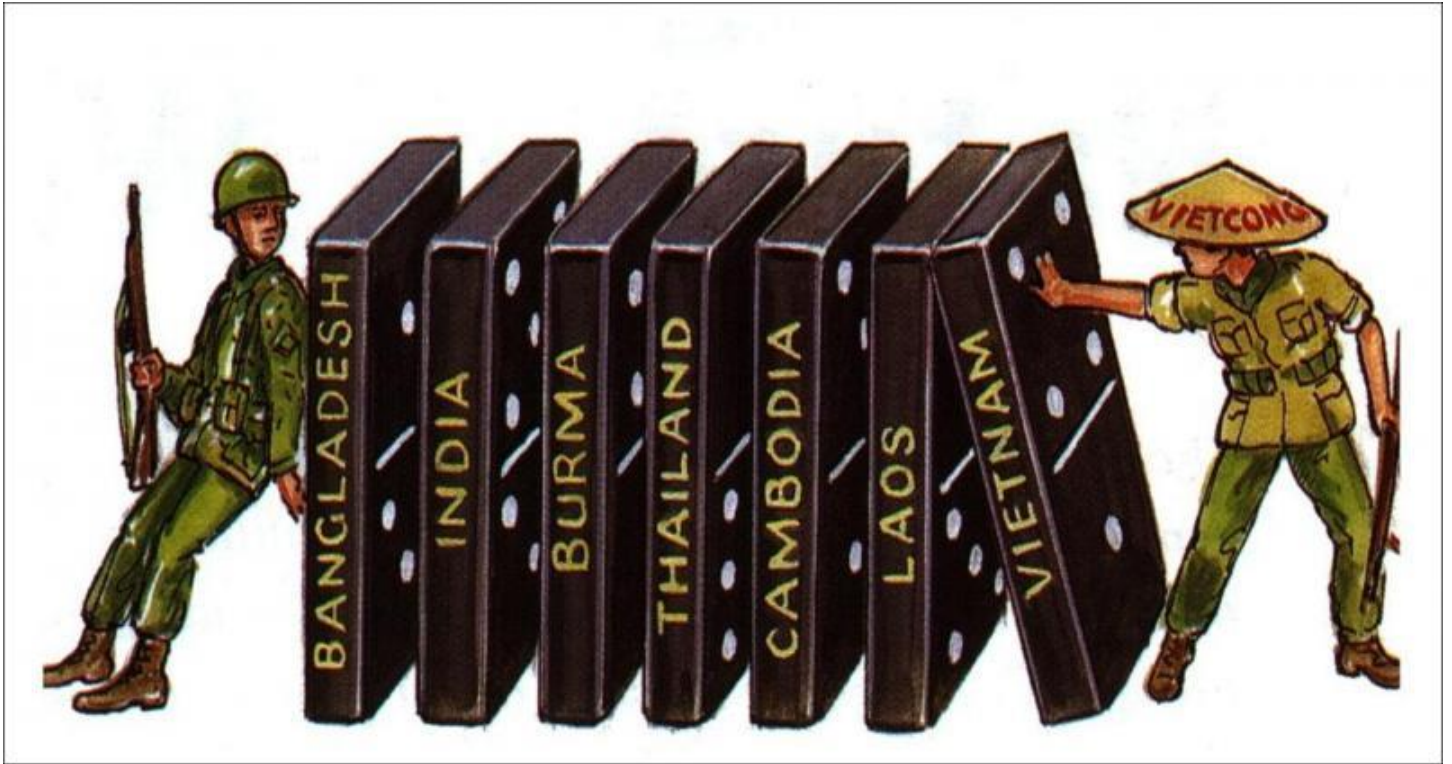
THE GAP IN THE BRIDGE.
